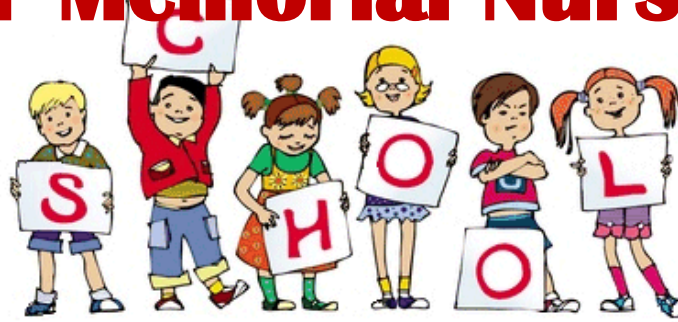

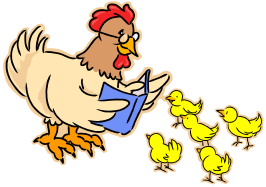

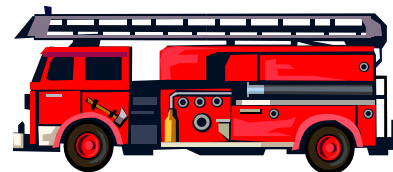

A Few Reminders:

- 1) **Immunization Records:** IMPORTANT! Please send in a copy of your child's immunization records if you have not already done so. When the state audits a facility that does not have records for each student, heavy fines are imposed. *Immunization records are due October 31st.*
- 2) **Safety:** We are a **NUT FREE SCHOOL!** Please read the labels on all packages; if it says "**Made in a facility that processes other products that may contain nuts**" we cannot serve it. As Halloween approaches you may be inclined to send treats in with your child to share. Please: **NO CANDY**, as candy often is processed in a nut factory.
- 3) **Outside:** Since the weather is good, we will go outside. In the morning there is dew and we do our best to wipe down everything. Please have extra clothes if your child walks through a puddle or grass is wet. Thank you!
